


## DASHBOARD

**Detalles de la sesión:** Big data y data science están jugando un papel cada vez más importante en nuestra vida personal y profesional. Hasta la fecha, la mayoría de los evaluadores han sido relativamente lentos para incorporar las nuevas técnicas de recopilación de datos, como imágenes satelitales, análisis de redes sociales, registros de centros de llamadas telefónicas, datos audiovisuales de teléfonos móviles, datos de búsqueda en Internet y datos de transferencias financieras de cajeros automáticos en sus evaluaciones. Del mismo modo, la mayoría de los evaluadores no utilizan herramientas de ciencia de datos como el aprendizaje automático, la inteligencia artificial y el análisis predictivo en el análisis de sus evaluaciones. El seminario web revisará el potencial emocionante de Big Data y Data Science para fortalecer las evaluaciones y presentará estudios de casos para ilustrar cómo estas técnicas ya se están aplicando en el campo. Sin embargo, el seminario web también revisará los desafíos técnicos, organizativos, económicos, políticos y éticos involucrados en la integración de Big Data en la forma en que se organizan, conducen y utilizan las evaluaciones. Se distribuirá a los participantes una nota que presenta los grandes datos y sus aplicaciones para la evaluación antes del seminario web.
