


5 Platforms to host a webinar

Cisco Webex

- Free account allows up to 100 participants
- No meeting time limit
- Provides chat, screen sharing, recording, file transfer, and Facebook live integration
- Free 30-day trial available with added features, such as multiple hosts

Zoom

- Free account allows up to 100 participants - but with a 40 minutes limit per meeting
- Includes chat, screen sharing, recording - file transfer, and Facebook live integration
- 30 -day free trial requires approval - (apply early!). It allows 100 participants with 24 hour meeting limit
- Some regional restrictions apply -

Join me

- Free 14-day trial allows up to 250 participants
- Provides chat, multiple video streams, recording, and Facebook live integration

WebinarJam

- 14-day trial for \$1: allows 2 presenters - and 500 participants for 2 hours
- Provides chat, recording and - collaboration tools

Social Media

- Facebook and YouTube allow you to host a live video for followers
- Facebook allows 4 hours of video and YouTube 36 hours
- Viewers can comment and react to videos

A webinar offers the option to reach people outside your location without requiring you to spend additional resources to communicate with them.




Interactivity
