To coincide with the 2021 gLOCAL Evaluation Week (<a href="https://glocalevalweek.org/">https://glocalevalweek.org/</a>), MES will be hosting a special EvalKlinik session to introduce the foundations of the Program Logic & Linkages (ProLL) model.

#### About the session

Developing Countries are gradually moving towards an integrated approach to Performance Management and Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) for sustainability and for better program management as advocated under Managing for Development Results (MfDR) and reduced redundancy when managing broader results areas that ultimately results in cost reduction.

The results-based budgeting system is focused on managing for results both at the output and outcome levels. It is also integrated into a number of complementary public sector management performance management initiatives, all of which are intended to provide public sector managers with appropriate management tools. One such tool is the the ProLL Model, which is an extension of the commonly used linear logic model but with a holistic approach to Planning, Execution and M&E.

In ProLL, the origins of the outcomes are identified so that the problems and needs are targeted for resolution within the existing policy environment. It's a model that works very well within the Public-Sector where policy implementation is key to addressing not only beneficiary needs and problems but also the broader stakeholder needs and problems. This model applies program logic in performance planning, program execution and M&E within a programmatic or an administrative structure.

Monitoring and Evaluation is a vital component in the dynamics of the ProLL Model, as key monitoring and evaluation points are identified and causal relationships established during the planning stage. The objective of the session is to provide basic skills and tools as well mainstream evaluation thinking in public domain. This is part of MES monthly virtual eval clinics, conducted since mid-2020.

### **About the Speakers**

**Dr. Arunaselam Rasappan** is Senior Advisor, Center for Development & Research in Evaluation (CeDRE) International, and the Founding President of MES. He has been a principal trainer for the Govt of M'sia on budgeting, program evaluation and performance management since 1991. He has also provided M&E training for international organisations such as UNDP, World Bank, Asian Development Bank, and other donors and has been an IRBM and M&E advisor for various governments in in Africa, Asia, Caribbean, and Middle East.

**Mr Koshy Thomas** work as an Advisor (Reform Specialist) on Budget Reforms with the Ministry of Economy and Finance, Royal Government of Cambodia, since June 2016, after retiring as the Undersecretary of the Corporate Strategy and Communication Division, Ministry of Finance in Malaysia. During his time with the Ministry, was also the appointed as Head to lead a Task Force, set up to implement Outcome-based Budgeting in whole of Government. Internationally, Koshy has worked collaboratively with World Bank, ADB, UNDP, WHO and UNICEF in numerous counties in East and South Asia, Africa, and Central Asia on scoping missions, training and advisory on Policy Formulation, Fiscal Policy, National Development Planning, Performance Budgeting, Performance Monitoring & Evaluation.
